

Kirk in the Hills is planning a pilgrimage of spiritual growth and enrichment to Egypt. We will encounter the religious experiences of the ancient Egyptians and discover the roots of our own Biblical origins. This is a country that saved Jacob's family from starvation, educated Moses, and shielded Jesus from Herod's wrath.

We will have the opportunity to visit the monumental remains of Pharaonic Egypt with its magnificent historical treasures as well as modern Egypt's mosques, squares and the Nile. We will visit the cities of Cairo, Alexandria and Luxor.

We will meet members of the Coptic church, visit some of the oldest mosques and learn what it is like to live as a Christian in a predominantly Muslim country.

Our tour guide is the esteemed Old Testament scholar, Dr. Theodore Hiebert. He has a Ph.D. in Classical Hebrew and Hebrew Scriptures, a M.Div. from Princeton Theological Seminary and a B.A. in English Literature from Fresno Pacific University. ## Worship/Music Notes

In worship today we are focusing on the Bible, God's Word to us, and seeing God's love for us on every page. As we gather, we open with a prayer *Blessed Jesus*, at Your Word, for our "hearts and minds to be stirred" at the hearing of the Word. In our opening hymn *God of the Ages*, Whose Almighty Hand, we bestow adoration and praise on God whose word is our law, and fills "all our lives with love and grace divine."

As we come to a time of prayer, we hear the choir sing, *Where Cross the Crowded Ways of Life* about hearing God's voice amidst the storms, despite our and humanity's failings. It is out of the grace we have received that we give of ourselves, and in preparation for the giving of our tithes and offerings, we sing together *I Love to Tell the Story*, sharing the "message of salvation from God's Word...of Jesus and his love." We then hear the soloist sing that very story in *I Am His and He Is Mine*, a hymn penned with an intimate knowledge of how God loves us with an "everlasting love."

In preparation to hear the word, the choir sings "Word that speaks your Father's love" and we again hear the tune of Liebster Jesu (Dearest Jesus), an often sung choral prayer for illumination. After the Word is proclaimed, we respond by singing Blessed Assurance, Jesus Is Mine, a long-cherished hymn of comfort. We know that in spite of all the trials that may come, we serve a Savior who has come to bring God's Kingdom on earth. As we strive each day to follow him, "filled with his goodness, lost in his love," we can say that salvation in Christ and our relationship with him is our story and our song!
