



WORSHIP NOTES

Worship/Music Notes

Both voluntaries are based on the hymn tune *Wachet auf*, found in our hymnal with the text “Sleepers, Wake!” A Voice Astounds Us (Hymn 349). The text is based on the parable of the wise and foolish bridesmaids (Matthew 25: 1-13) and is commonly sung during Advent. Philipp Nicolai wrote both the text and tune, which dates from 1599. Johann Ludwig Krebs (baptized 1713-1780) was a German Baroque organist who studied with Bach. The closing voluntary by J.S. Bach (1685-1750) is one of the most famous of Bach’s organ works, and comes from a cantata based on the same tune. Toward the end of his life, Bach arranged the cantata movement for organ and included it in his collection we call the Schübler Chorales.
