



## Chancel Choir Section Leader/Staff Singer Interview/Audition Procedure

Please be prepared to sing:

\*One solo from the sacred music repertoire (preferably a solo from an oratorio, cantata, mass, requiem, etc.). A pianist will be provided; please bring an extra copy of your music. Memorization is not expected or required.

\*The chorus "How lovely is thy dwelling-place" (4. Wie lieblich sind deine Wohnungen) from the Brahms German Requiem (Ein deutsches Requiem), as you would sing it in a choir. Please sing in English. A copy will be provided in advance if you need one, or you can find it on IMSLP or CPDL.

\*The anthem "Hallelujah, Amen!" from Handel's Judas Maccabeus. The music will be provided for you in advance if you need it, or you can find it on IMSLP (Act III, 41b) or CPDL. You should prepare it as you would prepare for a choir rehearsal.

You may also be asked to sight-sing a brief passage.
